STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY

REPORT ON FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM STUDENTS

Preamble

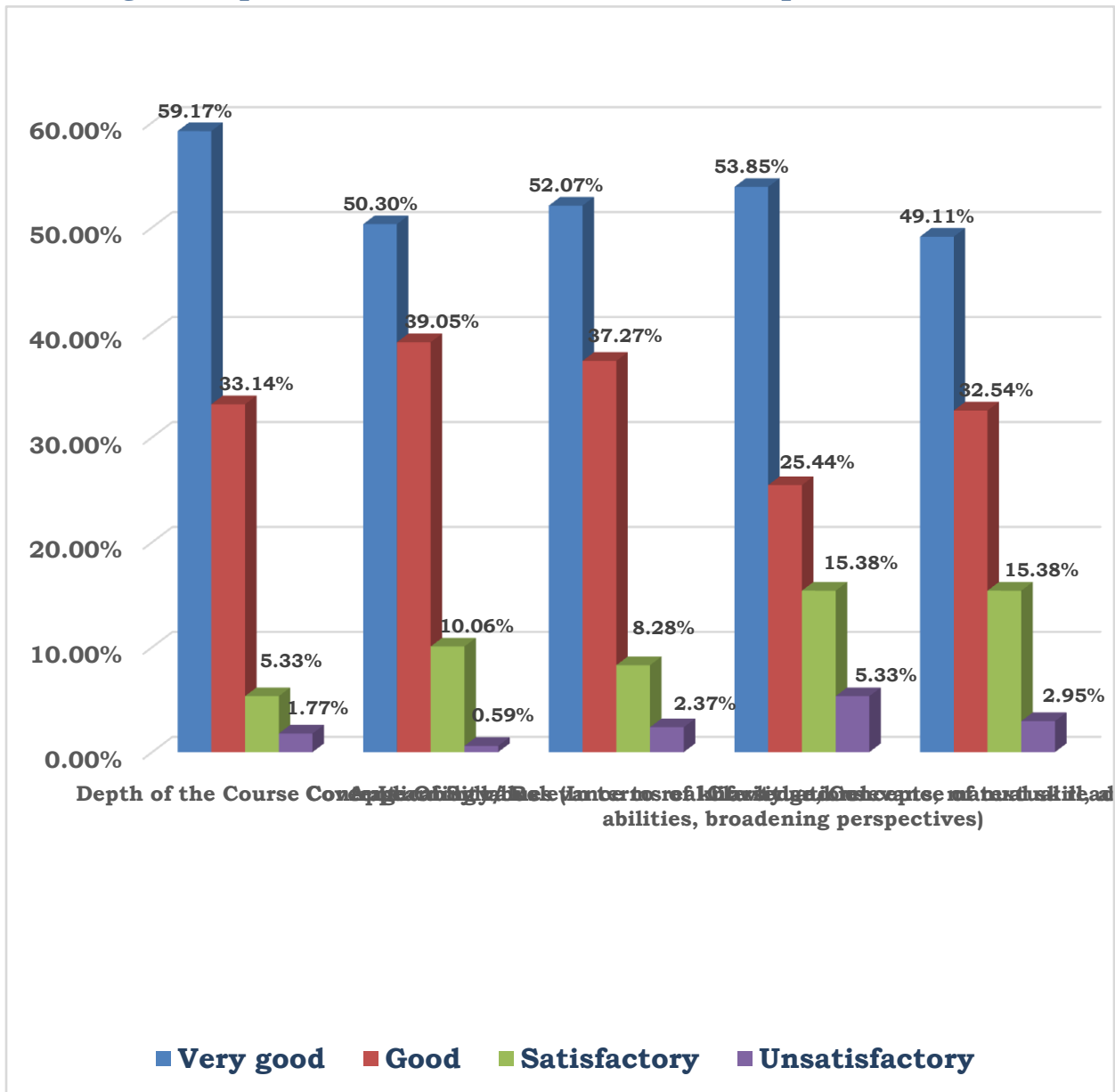
A survey was conducted among all students to get suitable feedback on major aspects like curriculum, professional knowledge, practice and engagement of teachers, library resources and infrastructure, co-curricular programmes that develop moral values and academic and non-academic programmes of the college that develop the knowledge and skills.

Students feedback and suggestion was obtained during the PTA meeting. It is rated on a 4 point scale. A total of 392 students have responded to this questionnaire. Majority of the students 80.49% have expressed that Academic and Non-academic programmes of the college develop the knowledge and skills of the student. 40.85% of students are content with Co-curricular programmes that develop moral values of the student. 15.38% of students are satisfied with Learning values (In terms of knowledge, Concepts, manual skill, analytical abilities, broadening perspectives) and Clarity and relevance of textual reading material.

Curricular Aspects

Among the elements of curricular aspects, Depth of the course content was rated to be excellent by the students. Students are extremely happy with coverage of syllabus. They are content with learning values (in terms of knowledge, concepts, manual skill, analytical abilities and broadening perspective) and clarity and relevance of textual reading material.

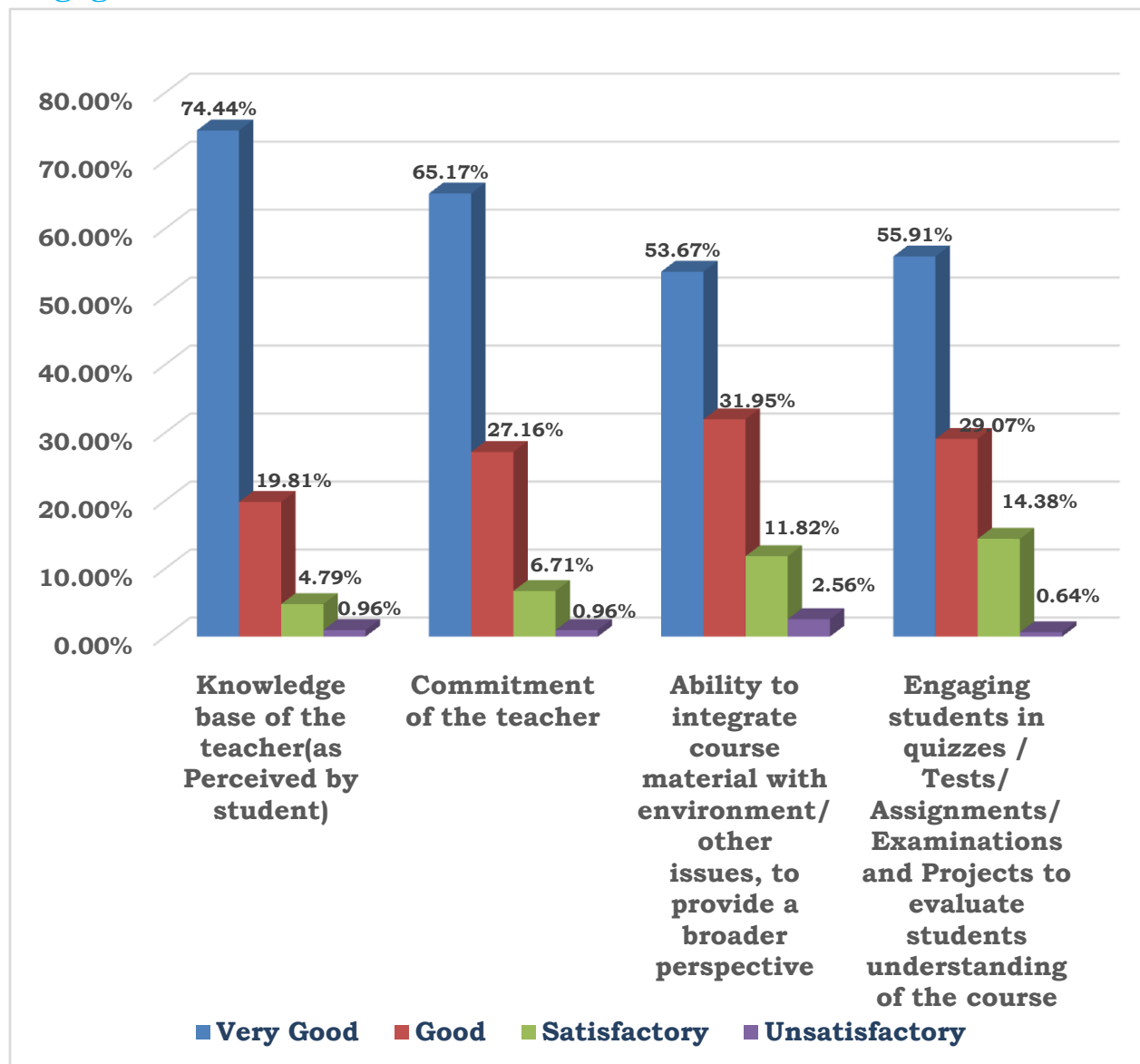
Fig. 1. Responses from students for curricular aspects



Professional Knowledge, Practice and Engagement of Teachers

Conceptualization and practical knowledge of the faculty has been rated as excellent by nearly 74.44% of students. 65.17% of students have indicated that they are content with the way textbook learning is blended with contextual learning that gives the students a broader perspective. Students are satisfied with conduction of quizzes, tests, assignment, etc to enhance their understanding.

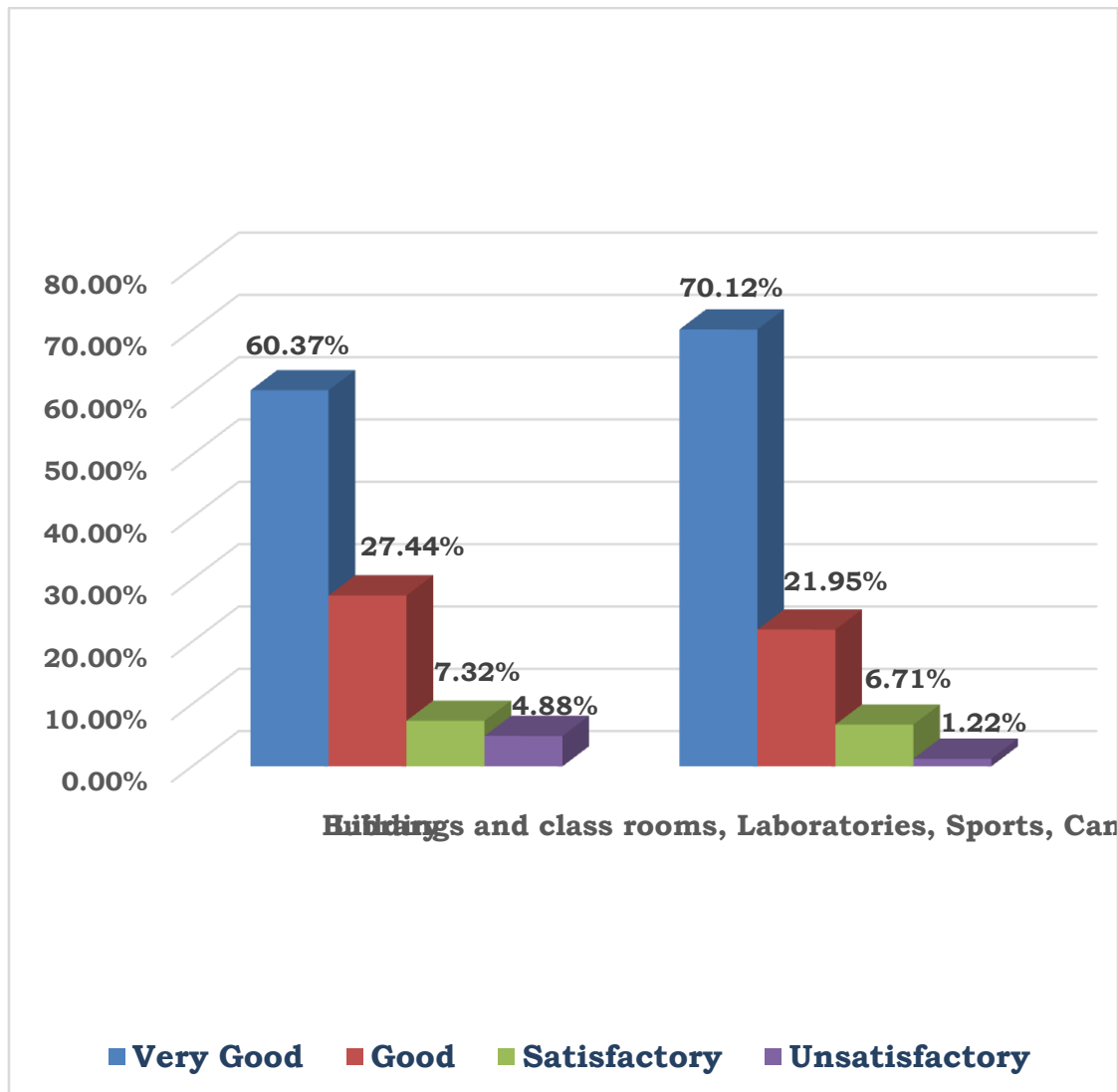
Fig. 2. Responses from students for Professional Knowledge, Practice and Engagement of Teachers



Library Resources and Infrastructure

Among all 60.37% have given the highest rating for library resources. Students are highly satisfied other facilities (Buildings and class rooms, Laboratories, Sports, Canteen, Hostel) as 70.12% of students rated it as excellent.
