Extract of Tamil Nadu Govt. Gazette — Extra ordinary dt. 29-01-1997 (Bill. No.8 at 1997 Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act).

1. Ragging means display of noisy, disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or is likely to cause psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or scheme or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes:

Education is the manifestation of the Perfection that mankind has

- (a) Teasing, abusing or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such student.
- (b) Asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course willingly act or perform.
- 2. Ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.
- 3. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates, abets or propagates "Ragging" within or outside any educational institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall also be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution.

THE COLLEGE EMBLEM



DESCRIPTION

Lord Krishna with flute in hand signifies that the college was established and is being administered by Yadava Community for whom Shri Krishna is the principal deity. Kuthuvilaku symbolically stands for enlightenment — dispelling ignorance and enriching knowledge. Cow (Kamadhenu) connotes endowment of wealth especially wealth of knowledge. The open book in the emblem signifies the importance of formal education. Thus the college is the spring of knowledge and wisdom that enriches the downtrodden society. The tower in the middle of the emblem is reflective of the college which is a temple of knowledge. The motto written at the bottom — ARIVEA SELVAM — means Wisdom is Wealth.

A BRIEF HISTORY

The Yadava Educational Fund was established by a few leading service minded Yadava Community people in the year 1962. The aim of the fund was to award scholarship and supply books to the deserving school students. The realization of the importance of the higher education for the socially and educationally backward Yadava Community people led to establishment of the Yadava College in the year 1969. It is run purely on donation received from Yadava Community philanthropists all over the country. Any one from Yadava Community who subscribes a minimum of Rs. 250/- and above up to 1993 and Rs. 500/- and above beyond 1994 can become a Life Member of the General Body of the Fund. The management constituted by the elected members of the General Body administers the college since 1971.

The college was started with two pre-university courses in a temporary building. The Tamilnodu Government generously allotted 40 acres of land under Thiruppalai Panchayat limits in the year 1969. In the same year a Hostel building was constructed. The college started functioning in the new premises from the academic year 1970-71.

At present the college is a Co-educational institution in which 3500 students pursue their higher education. About 628 Students stay in hostels. There is a separate hostel for women students in the College Campus. The College offers 19 Under Graduate Courses, 9 Post Graduate Courses, 6 Research Courses and 18 job Oriented Certificate and Diploma Courses of the Madurai Kamarai University. The college offers 41 free Certificate and 4 Diploma courses. The Department of Tamil, Commerce and Zoology have been elevated as Centre for Higher Research and offer Full Time as well as PartTime M.Phil and Ph.D programmes. A Modern library with 55,361 volumes, an IT Block and a Science block with three

floors depict the dedicated hard work of the managing council for the development of the college. Library is equipped with modern computer facilities with latest journals in all subjects. Students of Yadava College earn name and fame to the college by participating in sports activities at the Zonal and university levels and have won university Championships in the games like Volley Ball, Kabadi, and Athletics etc. N.C.C was established in the year 1972 in the college. Seven units of N.S.S. successfully carry out various extension activities. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council has re-accredited our college and has given 'A' Grade. in the year 2011. Madurai Kamaraj University has adjudicated the college and given the "Best College Award". The college wishes the young and energetic youth to use this campus for their upliftment.

EVALUATION SYSTEM

Important events of the evaluation process

- In every Semester, two centralized internal assessment tests will be conducted.
- Semester examinations will be held in November and April for the odd and even semesters respectively.
- Application for the semester examination will be issued from the Controller of Examination office.
- Students should verify the details such as name, register number and subjects of examinations in the application form.
- Students should pay the examination fees in the college branch of the Central Bank of India on or before the notified due date.
- Examination application, signed by the student and forwarded by the Head of the Department, must be submitted to the office of the Controller of the Examinations on or before the due date.
- 7. Application will not be accepted after the due date.
- Hall Tickets will be issued to the students by the office of the Controller of Examination on production of the No Dues certificates.
- 9. It is mandatory for a student to bring the Hall Ticket and Identity Card for all examinations.
- 10. Semester examination results will be published through college website and also be displayed in the notice board.
- 11. Supplementary examinations will be conducted for the outgoing batch of students.

HOSTEL

The college has separate hostel for boys and girls. The hostel is administered by the Warden (The Principal), a Deputy Warden and Sub Wardens.

Study hours are arranged for the benefit of the hostel students. Library, Computer, Sports facilities are sufficiently provided in the evening times to the hostel students so that they can update their knowledge in all areas.

Students of Yadava College alone is admitted in the college hostel.

Fee will be collected as per the above schedule. Mess bill is calculated on the basis of dividing system. The inmates have to pay their mess bill every month within 10 days after the bill amount is displayed. Otherwise Rs.1.00 will be collected as penalty for each day till the payment is made. No amount either in part or in full will be refunded for the student who leaves the Hostel in the middle of the Semester.

At the end of the year after adjusting dues, if any, the remaining amount of the caution deposit will be refunded.

Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals are available in the hostel. Students will not be allowed to take the meals to their rooms except on valid health grounds. Without prior permission of the sub-wardens, the inmates are not allowed to interchange their rooms. For any reason at any time the room for an inmate may be changed but when he leaves the room he/she must hand over furniture and electric goods in the room safely to the sub-wardens.

The inmates should not stay in the hostel without attending classes.

Without disturbing other students, the inmates have to keep silence at the time of study hours.

Every day the inmates must be present in their hostel from 6:00 p.m. onwards, if not, it is an offence. If an inmate is not present in the room at 6:00 p.m. onwards, he will be dismissed from the hostel.

The hostel inmates should not organize meetings, collect donations, send circular without the permission of the subwardens.

Playing cards, taking liquor, damaging walls, polluting the campus and plucking leaves and plants are not allowed

Inmates should not keep valuables in the hostel rooms any such thing if lost, the hostel administration is not responsible.

The Library is the heart of the institution. It is to promote sharing of resources by collecting, storing and disseminating information and by offering computerized services to the users.

History of the Library:

The College Library was established in the year 1969.

Thiru. E. Rengasamy Konar, one of the founders and former Correspondent of Yadava College donated all the books of "Erulappa Konar Library" founded by him at North Masi Street, Madurai. The college library was initially started with these volumes. Late Thiru. Chellaperumal, Late. Thiru, S. Sundararajan, Dr. K. Ramanujan, Mr. K Arunagiri, Prof. K Baskaran, formerly the Joint Director of Collegiate Education and Dr. N. Ramalingam had presented hundreds of rarely available books to the college library.

Collections & Facilities:

Our college library is functioning in a separate building and possesses all modern facilities, which fulfills the needs of the students with regard to the latest developments in different areas of study. The library is also equipped with Internet browsing centre, Intranet facility, talking book library for visually challenged students, audio-visual center, reprography facility, digital library with educational CDs, e-Books, e-Journals, separate reading room for the research scholars and the teachers, reference section, back volumes section, career corner, online public access catalogue and UGC-Inflibnet e-resources. All students of Yadava College are members of this library.

Our Library is getting access to e-resources through programme entitled "National Library and Information Services infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST)" funded by the Ministry of Human Resource Development under is National Mission on Education through ICT. The N-LIST project provides access to e-resources to students, researchers and faculty from colleges and other beneficiary institutions through server(s) installed at the INFLIBNET Centre. This programme would provide access to more than 3,717 e-journals (including current issues with 5-10 years back files) and 74,138 e-books. The resources would be accessible from http://nlist.inflibnet.ac.in. Following is the list of E-Resources.

Rules and Regulations:

The rules and regulations to be followed in the library are given below:

- 1. Membership is open to all staff and students of the college.
- Library is available from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days. During examination time, it is open from 8.00 a.m. to 7.30 p.m. and on holidays it is between 10.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m.
- All members of the library shall enter their names and sign legibly in the register which is kept at the entrance of the library.
- 4. While entering the readers should leave their personal belongings, such as bags, brief-cases, personal books, and parcels near the counter reserved for this purpose. However, they can carry loose papers and note books.
- All members must bring their identity cards issued by the college while using the library and a member must use his/her own identity cards only.

Rules are made for People who are not willing to make up their own.

- Readers should maintain silence in the library and should not disturb other users in anyway.
- 7. Using mobile Phones inside the library is prohibited.
- Books or other materials taken from the stacks should not be re- shelved by the readers but should be left on the tables reserved for this purpose.
- Readers should not deface, mark, cut and mutilate library materials in anyway. If anyone is found doing so, he/she will be charged the full replacement cost of the material.
- 10. If any of the books borrowed from the library is lost or damaged the borrower has to either return a new copy of the book or has to pay the prize of the book or has to pay the amount prescribed by the College.
- Library's internet Browsing and photocopying services are fee based.
- If the borrowed books are not returned to the library, the college will not issue Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate of the student.
- Not withstanding anything contained in these rules, the decision of the authorities of the college in all matters shall be final.

Issue of Books:

- 1. Library has an open access system.
- 2. Library services are fully computerized.
- Books are issued to the students and staff with barcoding system.

- OPAC system is available for book availability and other searching purposes.
- Reference books, Encyclopedias, Hand Books, Dictionaries, Periodicals, Students Project, and back volumes will not be issued and they are used only for reference.
- One renewal will be permitted if there are no reservations against these books. For renewal, books have to be presented physically at the library counter.
- 7. Members, before leaving the counter must satisfy themselves as to whether the books, which they intend to borrow, are in good condition and any damage/marking should be immediately reported to the librarian failing which the member to whom the book was issued will be held responsible.
- 8. Books are issued to the students as follows.

- Fifteen Books are issued to faculty members for a period of 90 days.
- 10. Five Books are issued to Administrative Staff for a period of 14 days.
- 11. The issue of library materials ends at 1.00 p.m on holidays and 5.30 p.m on all other days.

- 1. When a member leaves the college he/she shall return all the books.
- 2. Books must be returned on or before the due date noted in the due date slip. If the day happens to be a holiday, the book must be returned on the next working day. If any student keeps any book beyond the due date of return, overdue charges will be collected as per the existing rules.
- 3. Loss of books, if any, should be reported to the librarian immediately and it should be replaced with a new copy along with a levy of overdue charges if any.
- 4. In case the borrower is unable to replace the books that are lost, he/she will be levied a penallty as per the existing rules of overdue charges, if any.
- Absence from the college will not be allowed as an excuse for the delay in the return of books.
