Extract of Tamil Nadu Govt. Gazette – Extra ordinary dt. 29-01-1997 (Bill. No.8 at 1997 Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act).

1. Ragging means display of noisy, disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or is likely to cause psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or scheme or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes :

Education is the manifestation of the
Perfection that mankind has

- (a) Teasing, abusing or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such student; or
- (b) Asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course willingly act or perform.

2. Ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.
3. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates abets or propagates "Ragging" within or outside any educational institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
4. Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall also be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution.

THE COLLEGE EMBLEM



DESCRIPTION

Lord Krishna with flute in hand signifies that the college was established and is being administered by Yadava Community for whom Shri Krishna is the principal deity. Kuthuvilaku symbolically stands for enlightenment – dispelling ignorance and enriching knowledge. Cow (Kamadhenu) connotes endowment of wealth especially wealth of knowledge. The open book in the emblem signifies the importance of formal education. Thus the college is the spring of knowledge and wisdom that enriches the downtrodden society. The tower in the middle of the emblem is reflective of the college which is a temple of knowledge. The motto written at the bottom – **ARIVEA SELVAM** – means Wisdom is Wealth.

A BRIEF HISTORY

The Yadava Educational Fund was established by a few leading service minded Yadava Community people in the year 1962. The aim of the fund was to award scholarship and supply books to the deserving school students. The realization of the importance of the higher education for the socially and educationally backward Yadava Community people led to establishment of the Yadava College in the year 1969. It is run purely on donation received from Yadava Community philanthropists all over the country. Any one from Yadava Community who subscribes a minimum of Rs.250/- and above up to 1993 and Rs.500/- and above beyond 1994 can become a Life Member of the General Body of the Fund. The management constituted by the elected members of the General Body administers the college since 1971.

The college was started with two pre-university courses in a temporary building. The Tamilnadu Government generously allotted 40 acres of land under Thiruppalai Panchayat limits in the year 1969. In the same year a Hostel building was constructed. The college started functioning in the new premises from 1970-71 academic year.

At present the college is a Co-educational institution in which 3500 students pursue their higher education. About 628 Students. stay in hostels. There is a separate hostel for women students in the College Campus. The College offers 19

Under Graduate Courses, 9 Post Graduate Courses, 6 Research Courses and 18 job Oriented Certificate and Diploma Courses of the Madurai Kamaraj University. The college offers 41 free certificate and 4 diploma courses. The Department of Tamil, Commerce and Zoology have been elevated as Centre for Higher Research and offer Full Time as well as PartTime M.Phil and Ph.D programmes. A Modern library with 40,000 volumes, an IT Block and a Science block with three floors depict the dedicated hard work of the managing council for the development of the college. Library is equipped with modern computer facilities with latest journals in all subjects. Students of Yadava College earn a name and fame to the college by participating in sports activities at the Zonal and university levels and won the university Winners in the games like Volley Ball, Kabadi, and Athletics etc. N.C.C was established in the year 1972 in the college. Seven units of N.S.S. successfully carry out various extension activities.

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council has Re-accredited our college and has given 'A' Grade. Madurai Kamaraj University has adjudicated the college and given the **"Best College Award"**. The College has been conferred with **Autonomous Status** by the University Grants Commission **In 2006**. The college wishes the young and energetic youth to use this campus for their upliftment.

EVALUATION SYSTEM

Import ant events of the evaluation process

1. In every Semester, Three centralized internal assessment tests will be conducted.
2. Semsters examinations will be held in November and April for the odd and even semester respectively.
3. Application for the semester examination will be issued by from the Controller or Examination office.
4. Students should verify the details in the application such as name, register number and subjects of examinations.
5. Studens should pay the examination fees in the college branch of the Central Bank of India on or before the notified due date.
6. Examination application, signed by the student and forwarded by the Head of the Department, must be submitted to the office of the Controller of the Examination on or before the due date.
7. Application will not be accepted after the due date.
8. Hall Tickets will be issued to the students by the office of the Controller of Examination on prduction of the No Dues certificates.
9. It is mandatory for a student to bring the Hall Ticket and Identify Card for all examinations.
10. Semester examination results will be published through college website and also displayed in the notice board.
11. Supplementary examinations will be conducted for the outgoing batch of students.

HOSTEL

The college has separate hostel for gents and ladies. The hostel is administered by the Warden (The Principal), a Deputy Warden and Sub Wardens.

Study hours are arranged for the benefit of the hostel students. Library, Computer, Sports facilities are sufficiently provided in the evening times to the hostel students so that they can update their knowledge in all areas.

Students of Yadava College alone is admitted in the college hostel.

Fee will be collected as per the above schedule. Mess bill is calculated on the basis of dividing system. The inmates have to pay their mess bill every month within 10 days after the bill amount is displayed. Otherwise Rs.1.00 will be collected as penalty for each day till the payment is made. No amount either in part or in full will be refunded for the student who leaves the Hostel in the middle of the Semester.

At the end of the year after adjusting dues, if any, the remaining amount of the caution deposit will be refunded.

Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals are available in the hostel. Students will not be allowed to take the meals to their rooms except on valid health grounds. Without prior permission of the sub-wardens, the inmates are not allowed to interchange their rooms. For any reason at any time the room for an inmate may be changed but when he leaves the room he must hand over furniture and electric goods in the room safely to the sub-wardens.

The inmates should not stay in the hostel without attending classes.

Without disturbing other students, the inmates have to keep silence at the time of study hours.

Every day the inmates must be present in their hostel from 9:00 p.m. onwards, if not, it is an offence. If an inmate is not present in the room at 8:00 p.m. onwards, he will be dismissed from the hostel.

The hostel inmates should not organize meetings, collect donations, send circular without the permission of the subwardens.

Playing cards, taking liquor, damaging walls, polluting the campus and plucking leaves and plants are not allowed.

Inmates should not keep valuables in the hostel rooms any such thing if lost, the hostel administration is not responsible.

Ramanujan, Mr. K Arunagiri, Prof. K Baskaran, formerly the Joint Director of Collegiate Education and Dr.N. Ramalingam had presented hundreds of rarely available books to the college library.

Collections & Facilities :

Our college library is functioning in a separate building and possesses all modern facilities, which fulfills the needs of the students with regard to the latest developments in different areas of study. The library is also equipped with Internet browsing centre, Intranet facility, talking book library for visually challenged students, audio-visual center, reprography facility, digital library with educational CDs, e-Books, e-Journals, separate reading room for the research scholars and the teachers, reference section, back volumes section, career corner, online public access catalogue and UGC-Inflibnet e-resources. All students of Yadava College are members of this library.

Rules and Regulations:

The rules and regulations to be followed in the library are given below:

1. Membership is open to all staff and students of the college.
2. The working hours of the library on all working days and examination time are 8.30 a.m. to 7.30 p.m. and on holidays it is open between 10.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m.
3. All members of the library shall enter their names and sign legibly in the register which is kept at the entrance of the library.
4. While entering the readers should leave their personal belongings, such as bags, brief-cases, personal books, and parcels near the counter reserved for this purpose. However, they can carry loose papers and note books.

willing to make up their own.

5. All members must bring their identity cards issued by the college while using the library and a member must use his / heir identity cards only.
6. Readers should maintain silence in the library and should not disturb other users in anyway.
7. Using of mobile Phones inside the library is prohibited.
8. Books or other materials taken from the stacks should not be re- shelved by the readers but should be left on the tables reserved for this purpose.
9. Readers should not deface, mark, cut and mutilate library materials in anyway. If anyone is found doing so, he/she will be charged the full replacement cost of the material.
10. If any of the books borrowed from the library is lost or damaged the borrower has to either return a new copy of the book or has to pay the current of the book or have to pay the amount prescribed by the librarian.
11. Library's internet Browsing and photocopying services are fee based.
12. If the borrowed books are not returned to the library, the college will not issue Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate of the student.
13. Not withstanding anything contained in these rules, the decision of the authorities of the college in all matters shall be final.

Issue of Books:

1. Library has an open access system.
2. Library services are fully computerized.

4. OPAC system is available for book availability and other searching purposes.
5. Reference books Encyclopedias, Hand Books, Dictionaries, Periodicals, Student Project, and back volumes will not be issued and they are used only for reference.
6. One renewal will be permitted if there are no reservations against these books. For renewal, books have to be presented physically at the library counter.
7. Members, before leaving the counter must satisfy themselves as to whether the books, which they intend to borrow, are in good condition and any damage/marking should be immediately reported to the librarian failing which the member to whom the book was issued will be held responsible.
8. Books are issued to the students as follows.
