While Subject Knowledge would be provided by Yadava College, Livewire will equip the students with required industry specific skills.

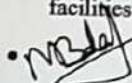

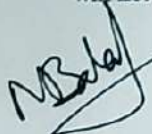

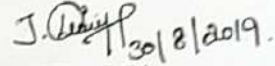
