Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the proposal submitted by Yadava College, Govindarajan Campus,
Thiruppalai, Madurai-625014, Tamilnadu affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University for extension
of autonomous status under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in
its meeting held on 12.05.2022, the Competent Authority has decided to extend the
autonomous status to Yadava College, Govindarajan Campus, Thiruppalai, Madurai-
625014, Tamilnadu affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University for a period of Five (05) years
from the session 2022-2023 to 2026-2027, including ex-post-facto approval for the period
2018-2019 to 2021-2022, as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations
dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding extension of
autonomous status to the College as per the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon
Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations,
2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The College, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per
the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The Autonomous College is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for
Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugu.ac.in.
Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action
as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations - 2018. Further, it may be noted that the above
said college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for
extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.


